

YOU! Health and Body Systems

- For their final class, students participated in a simulation that shows one aspect of the spread of infectious disease.
- Students each received a cup of “body fluid” and then had “interactions” with other students in the class by pouring the fluids together.
- An indicator was added – if a student’s “fluid” turned pink, they caught the disease. If it remained clear, they were well.
